Dear readers,

With this newsletter, we would like to inform you about the outcomes and final results of the EQUAL-CLASS project.

EQUAL-CLASS is a European Commission-funded project which aimed to analyse and compare qualifications in the field of **mechatronics, electronics/electrical engineering** across five different countries.

The qualifications were examined from three different perspectives – learning outcomes, learners, and graduates – with particular focus on their **classification within National Qualifications Frameworks (NQFs)** and the **European Qualifications Framework (EQF)**.

Remote Laboratories were used within EQUAL-CLASS to assess and compare learners' PLC (programmable logic controller) skills. In total, 150 learners from four different countries were awarded an EQUAL-CLASS certificate for successful participation in the EQUAL-CLASS project.
